Dr. Carr, I wanted to check with you about the possibility of a couple of American Tree Sparrow specimens in the ULM collection. Several decades ago, this species was reported from Claiborne Parish. Louisiana Tech supposedly collected a couple of specimens to verify the sighting. John Dillon, who is on the Louisiana Bird Records Committee, checked with LA Tech and was informed that the specimens are gone and were either disposed of or given to ULM. I wanted to follow-up to see if there is any chance they are at ULM. This would be the only hard evidence for this species in Louisiana. Is this something you could check? Thanks. Larry
