One species (Monk Parakeet) and two subspecies/forms (Great White Heron and Red-shafted Flicker) are not on the Official State List but are on the Review list. Monk Parakeet is included as a means to obtain information about *breeding expansion of feral population(s)*, and the two subspecies/forms were originally included on the State List but their status has been reviewed and found insufficient for official inclusion.
