- 9. Light conditions (position of bird in relation to shade and to direction and amount of light): It was approaching sunset when I found the bird on New Years Day, but there was excellent light on most other trips.
- 10. Optical equipment (type, power, condition): binoculars See my photos from each date.
- 11. Distance to bird(s): as close as 10 feet Much popcorn as well as other treats were used to bring it in closer.
- 12. Duration of observation: multiple observations and prolonged views at multiple times

- 13. Habitat: open water and on lakeside decks
- 14. Behavior of bird / circumstances of observation (flying, feeding, resting; include and stress habits used in identification; relate events surrounding observation): flying, feeding, and seen at rest on railings, and resting on water
- 15. Stress features that separate it from similar species): Medium size gull slightly smaller than Ring-billed Gull that resembled a miniature Herring Gull in plumage pattern. Thin yellow green bill with black terminal part showing no significant gonydeal angle. Very brownish overall with brownish underwings unlike Ring-billed Gull of similar age. Brownish black tail with gark mottled tail coverts unlike RBGU od similar age. Brownish crown and nape, and diffuse warm brown belly. Dark eye and brown ring around eye of this individual

- 17. Similar species (include how they were eliminated by your observation): RBGU eliminated by description above and documentary photos which are included in the record
