English and Scientific names: Tropical Kingbird, *Tyrannus melancholicus* 1 or 2.

(Because the sightings involve two closely associating birds, and I have only seen and heard one calling, I conservatively listed them in Ebird as 1 TRKI and 1 Tropical/Couch's Kingbird, *Tyrannus melancholicus/couchii*. Inasmuch as I have photos of both birds, but no way to know which bird in the photos is the calling Tropical, it seems pointless to try to do two separate reports. Indeed, it seems highly likely that two TRKI are involved.)

Location: Bayou Sauvage NWR, variously along road from Crabbing Bridge to Pointe aux Herbes, Orleans Parish, La.

Details: Two interacting yellow-bellied kingbirds; extensive bright yellow below, blending into greener, not gray, breast; pale throat, gray heads with darker mask; green backs, darker wings with pale edging on secondaries and in coverts; tail dark brown, forked. Bill black, long and wide.

Voice: A high pitched, insistent twittering given by at least one bird during interactions on 11/18/23.

Discussion: At least one Tropical Kingbird has been regular in several of the past few winters in this general area (from South Point to Pointe aux Herbes) along Lake Pontchartrain in Bayou Sauvage NWR. On both occasions this season these two birds were associating closely and interacting—on Jan. 16 after a hard freeze.
